Dates: Earliest possible start is May 15, 2023. Latest possible start is July 10, 2023. Flexible end date (at full time basis) up to Sept 03, 2022, depending on start date.

Hours: 35 per week or pro-rated to 30 hours per week as negotiated. Maximum total hours: 280

Remuneration: \$15.50 per hour

Location: Toronto (or home office based in Ontario)

First Lutheran Church and the Student Christian Movement collaborate to offer student outreach and campus ministry at Toronto Metropolitan University in the form of contextual Bible Studies and other programs. First Lutheran is a historic congregation nestled in the heart of TMU campus. SCM at Toronto Metropolitan University is a recognized student club of the TMU Student Union, TMU Student Life and Campus Engagement, and one of three SCM units in the GTA.

The Summer Intern will be responsible for supporting the established SCM TMU program offerings in collaboration and cross-sponsorship with SCM GTA and SCM Canada. The Summer Intern will support the program life and public relations of First Lutheran Church which may include worship leadership and preaching, social media campaigns and promotion, and other duties as agreed upon.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Toronto Metropolitan University Student Christian Movement (SCM TMU): to lead and support SCM TMU, through social media and online programs with SCM GTA and SCM Canada, eg., online Radical Bible Study, movie nights, and the SCM GTA fall retreat.
2. 2SLGBTQAI Faith-based programs: to support and deliver queer and trans positive events, eg, Brave Queer Space, etc.
3. First Lutheran social media: to animate First Lutheran social media accounts with suitable content, i.e., Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, website.

4. First Lutheran worship: to support, plan and participate in hybrid Sunday services including summer pastoral vacation replacement and technical support.
5. First Lutheran “Little Food Pantry”: to promote stocking of this food sustainability program.
6. Administration: to perform other and related tasks as assigned.

Qualifications

1. Graduate or mature undergraduate student with a passion for justice and community in theological perspective.
2. Excellent interpersonal communication skills, including group facilitation.
3. Self-motivated with the ability to take initiative and work online or in person.
4. Superior social media skills.

Key Competencies

1. Enthusiasm and ability to promote and deliver faith-based study programs, eg. Contextual Bible study.
2. Ability to sustain and build online student and young adult community in an evolving pandemic.
3. Be able understand, organize and lead programs in a Christian setting as part of a team of paid and volunteer leaders.

5. Excellent social intelligence, pro-active, and team-oriented workstyle.
